Event Itinerary;

After that, start judging cars until approx 5pm then a "Welcome Dinner".

Saturday- 9am judging cars, we should have at least 20 cars to be judged until till lunch break. After lunch, cars will be judged through till 5pm. Free night to do as you please.

Sunday- 9am Judging cars till lunch break, lunch then judge till 3pm. Return to accommodation to prepare for the Presentation Dinner/ Cruise on the Hawkesbury Paddle Wheeler leaving from Windsor for a 4 hour dinner tour. On the boat all the presentations and awards will be given, bringing the weekend and our first Chapter Meet to a close.

If you wish to have your car judged, you will need to become a member of NCRS Australia for only \$25.00 AUS, and you must also take up membership with NCRS US at \$55.00 US.
